Medaljes

In samewerking met die Suid-Afrikaanse Munt, herdenk ons die 150-jaarvieringe van Paul Roos Gimnasium met die vrystelling van 'n stel beperkte uitgawe silwer en goud medaljes. Die medaljes vier die heuglike gebeurtenis en bring hulde aan die menige legendes en tradisies van oud skoliere wat rolmodelle vir generasies van Paul Roosers geword het.

Slegs 2016 van die 1 oz silwer kroon medaljes is beskikbaar. Die voorkant van die medalje vertoon die skoolwapen, terwyl die spesiale 150 jaar gedenkingsembleem en die skool se naam in beide afrikaans en engels op die agterkant verskyn. Die 1/2 oz 24 karaat goud medalje vertoon dieselfde embleme en is beperk tot 150.

'n Baie beperkte honderd en vyftig spesiale-gedenkstelle is ook beskikbaar. Dit bevat beide medaljes in 'n spesiaal gegraveerde hout kissie.

Hierdie unieke medaljes is 'n besonderse wyse vir Paul Roosers om hul erfenis te gedenk.

Medallions

To mark the 150th anniversary of Paul Roos Gymnasium, we are proud to release limited edition silver and gold commemorative medallions, in partnership with the South African Mint. These medallions are the perfect tribute to such a momentous occasion. They celebrate the legacy and many traditions of Old Boys that have passed through as scholars and gone on to become role models for generations of Paul Roosers to follow.

Only 2016 of the 1 oz silver crown medallions and 150 of the 1/2 oz gold medallions will be made. The school crest appears on the obverse, while the reverse shows the special 150 year anniversary emblem and the school's name in both English and Afrikaans, on both medallions.

In addition to the single medallions, a very limited 150 sets will available, containing the two medallions in a specially carved wooden box.

These unique medallions are an auspicious commemoration of Paul Roos Gymnasium's proud heritage.
